You may see some changes when it is time for your next appointment. We made these changes to help protect our team and your family. For example:

- Toothbrushes, floss, and toothpaste will not be available at the office, so please BRUSH AT HOME before you leave for your appointment.
- If possible, please bring your own mask. If not, we will provide one.
- Our waiting room has moved... to your car! Upon arrival, check in via phone by calling 701-255-1311.
- We will meet you at your car where we will take your temperature and complete a health assessment questionnaire. We also require signature of a COVID-19 consent letter.
- Whenever possible, we ask the patient is the only one to enter our office.
